Regular Monthly Meeting  
February 13, 2023

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District No. 1, in the Township of South Brunswick, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman William Orchard, in compliance with the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act.

- Air Paks, which were ordered last April, will be arriving shortly. The bottles and harnesses should arrive in early March. The Face Pieces are not ready yet.
- Waiting for Budget to get approved so PM's can begin. Truck 221 will be first to go out.
- A broker will be coming to give an estimate of what the Company can get for the old 221.
