Regular Monthly Meeting
June 13, 2022

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District No 1 in the Township of South Brunswick, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman William Orchard, in compliance with the New Jersey Open Public Meetings act.

Line Activities – Chief Perez reported the following:

- A recruitment campaign was held on 6/2 and 6/9 at South Brunswick High School; as three companies participated in it. Four students are interested and are beginning the process.
- It was a busy month (monthly stats attached). There were two major fires, which the Company handled well, however, there was one civilian fatality.

Treasurer's Report/Voucher List – Ms. Berezansky presented the report (file copy attached). She reported that all monthly bills had been paid and everything is up to date. Fire Coordinator's Report – Mr. Perez updated the Board on the Fire Marshall situation. There was a meeting with the Township Administration-and there was a statement indicating that Deputy Fire Marshalls have firefighting included in their job descriptions, which would require them to be in the police and fire pension system.” Mr. Braslow was contacted to get a clarification if this is actually a requirement. Mr. Braslow has not gotten back with an answer.

Mr. Perez reported that the situation with District 3 is still an open issue.
