Regular Monthly Meeting

March 9, 2026

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District No. 1, in the Township of South Brunswick was called to order at 6:41 p.m. by Chairman Orchard, in compliance with the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act.

**Roll Call:**

**Approval of February regular meeting minutes:** Mr. White made a motion to approve the minutes as presented and Mr. Olson seconded it. A vote was taken and passed unanimously.

Line Activities – Mr. Perez reported that it had been a busy month, basically due to all the inclement weather. Stats will be on file, as soon as, completed.

Treasurer/Voucher List – Ms. Berezansky presented the report and stated that all bills had been paid. After review of the List, Mr. Hohmeier made a motion to accept it and Mr. White seconded it. A vote was taken and passed.

Fire Coordinator - Mr.Perez reported Truck Maintenance will state this month and a live burn is scheduled for 4/11; the First Aid Squad will be present. Finally, a vote for the new truck was approved. He will send a letter of intent to purchase the truck, which will begin the process.

Chairman - Mr. Orchard reported that he had received a note for non-compliance for his election, as did Mr. Olson. This issue will be addressed prior to next year's election.

He thanked everyone for voting but noted that there were more No votes than in the past. He suggested that a flyer be put out before the next election to let District know that they are a volunteer organization. It was suggested that Fire Company members might go door-to-door prior to the election next year and educate them, exactly as to what being a member of the Fire Company entails, as well as the cost it takes to keep the residents secure. Everyone agrees it was a good idea.

*Public Relations* - the budget passed. Mr. Perez reported that changes required of the Web Site are in the process of being done. As a requirement to advertise the change to residents, the 3 District will split the cost of twice a month advertising.
